



Cockroach Treatment Preparation

For: Mr Pest Control Treatment

Upon arrival of the service technician, you and your pets will be required to leave for a minimum of 4 hours.

Windows should be open, if possible during the treatment.

If you have fish tanks, they should be covered with a towel and the circulation system disconnected.

If you are pregnant, asthmatic or have other health issues you should be out for minimum of 24 hours.

Prior to technician's arrival all areas of house must be cleaned and vacuumed. Remove clutter off the floors and away from the walls (this does not include furniture, it should be left where it normally is).

Do not leave out any food, pet bowls or pet food.

If you wish to clean/wash your kitchen or bathroom cupboards please do so **prior** to our treatment. Using cleaning/chemical agents or pest control products/sprays in these areas after our visit will cause the treatment to not work.

A bait is used in our control procedure and can be easily contaminated and not taste good to the roaches. Please wait at least 30 days after our visit before washing or spraying the areas where our treatment has been applied.

IMPORTANT: To ensure a thorough and effective treatment the preparation/precautions must be followed. If not followed, you will significantly reduce the chances of eliminating the pest problem.

NOTE: It is not uncommon to still experience cockroach problems for 2 to 3 weeks following the treatment. The treatment is a process and it needs time to work!
