



Flea Treatment Preparation

For: Mr Pest Control Treatment

Upon arrival of the service technician, you and your pets will be required to leave for a minimum of 6 hours.

Windows should be open if possible during the treatment.

If you are pregnant, asthmatic or have other health concerns you should be out for a minimum of 24 hours.

If you have fish tanks they must be covered with a towel and the circulation system disconnected.

Prior to technician's arrival carefully VACUUM ALL FLOOR AREAS, carpeted and non-carpeted, including pet sleeping and resting areas, under furniture, under and between couch cushions, cracks and crevices in floors and draperies.

Remove the vacuum bag and place it into a plastic bag, seal it and dispose of it in an outside garbage.

if you have cats that rest on window sills and appliance tops, they need to be cleaned. Then hard floor areas must be cleaned (mopped and then vacuumed).

Remove all clutter off floors, furniture and away from the walls.

Do Not leave out any food, pet bowls or pet food. **Do Not** move furniture/beds etc. from its normal place.

Arrange to have dogs, cats and other flea-infested pets professionally treated by your local veterinary clinic at the same time the home is treated and put on a flea program.

IMPORTANT: Continue to Vacuum every few days after treatment. Do Not use cleaners or detergents on the floors for at least 3 weeks after treatment.

NOTE: It is not uncommon to still experience fleas for 2 to 3 weeks following the treatment. Treatment for fleas needs time to work!
